Phosphate Removal Tip Sheet



Application Instructions For PHOSfree Commercial With D.E. And Cartridge Filters

- **Step 1:** If pool has algae, follow dealer instructions to treat
- **Step 2:** Follow dealer instructions to balance water chemically

Note: Algae must be treated prior to testing and lowering phosphates. Chlorine must be under 5ppm before testing for phosphates

- Step 3: Start with a clean filter by soaking filters in Filter Perfect overnight
- **Step 4:** Once filter is clean, run pool with multiport set to filtration
- Step 5: Shake bottle. With circulation pump running, add appropriate dose to skimmer. See chart below
 - Do not add more than 1.5L (50oz) at a time
- **Step 6:** Allow pump to run 48 hours and monitor your pressure
 - To treat higher phosphate levels add 1.5L (50oz. or half a bottle) every 24 hours until desired result is obtained

Note: Clouding may occur. After 48 hours, vacuum to filter

- Step 7: Clean or backwash filter
- Step 8: Test phosphate level
 - If level is above 1000ppb, repeat steps 3 through 5
 - If level is below 1000ppb, refer to **PHOSfree** instructions

PHOSfree Commercial Dosage Chart

Phosphate Level	1000 PPB	2000 PPB
10,000 gal	Add 16oz (0.5L)	Add 32oz (1L)
20,000 gal	Add 32oz (1L)	Add 67.6oz (2L)

Application Instructions For PHOS*free* With D.E. and Cartridge Filters

- **Step 1:** If pool has algae, follow dealer instructions to treat
- **Step 2:** Follow dealer instructions to balance water chemically

Note: Algae must be treated prior to testing and lowering phosphates. Chlorine must be under 5ppm before testing for phosphates

- **Step 3:** Start with a clean filter by soaking filters in **Filter Perfect** overnight
- **Step 4:** Once filter is clean, run pool with multiport set to filtration
- Step 5: Determine appropriate PHOSfree dose. See chart below
 - Do not add more than 1.5L per application
- **Step 6:** Shake bottle. With circulation pump running add dose to skimmer
- **Step 7:** Run filter 8 hours per day for one week or 48 hours continuously without backwashing or cleaning **Note:** If DE filter pressure rises above normal, turn pump off for 10-15 seconds then turn back on. Repeat until pressure stays in normal range
- **Step 8:** Clean or backwash filter
- **Step 9:** Test phosphate level
 - If level is above 100ppb, repeat steps 3 through 5
 - If level is below 100ppb, begin applying **Pool Perfect+PHOS** weekly to maintain a low phosphate level
